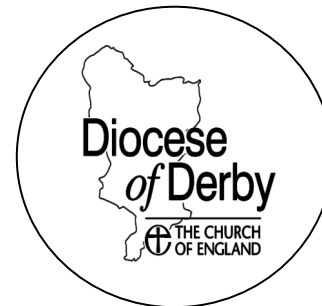

Is an opportunity for young people aged 13-18 (ish) from an Anglo Catholic Tradition to spend part of the half term relaxing together, exploring their identity and sharing their faith.

So what's going to happen at "Critical Mass"?

It's going to be fun packed and social, a chance to meet new friends and renew old acquaintances.

The Daily Mass will form the bedrock of the days programme, with guest celebrants from across the diocese coming to share the Mass with us.

Other times will be spent doing what The Peak Centre does best, with a choice of activities, ranging from Circus skills, climbing, abseiling, walking or archery. There will also be time for DVD's, quizzes, challenges and Games

Who's who?

Alistair Langton , Fr Adrian Murray-Leslie, and other priests and youth leaders (including female leaders) will keep you fed physically, spiritually and emotionally with good food, two sessions of outdoor activities and regular worship slots.

This is also a unique opportunity to hear about the Diocesan Youth Pilgrimage to Walsingham, which goes as a group in August every year.
